

## DIVISION X. MAINTENANCE

### Section 10.01. Removal of or Injury to Sewer

An unauthorized person shall not remove or cause to be removed, or injure or cause to be injured, any portion of any public sewer, sewage pumping plant, water pollution plant, or any appurtenances thereto.

### Section 10.02. Opening Manhole

An unauthorized person shall not open or enter, or cause to be opened or entered, for any purpose whatsoever, any manhole in any public sewer.

### Section 10.03. Dumping Effluent

The District Manager may permit operators of "Cesspool" pump trucks to dispose of septic tank, seepage pit or cesspool effluent which does not contain harmful concentrations of industrial liquid waste, oils, greases, or other deleterious substances into certain designated manholes, upon payment of the fee specified in Section 6. No person shall dump such effluent in any manhole other than those designated by the District Manager. The District Manager may refuse to accept such effluent if it fails to meet the aforementioned requirements.

### Section 10.04. Cleaning Manholes

When septic tank, seepage pit or cesspool effluent is dumped into a specified manhole under permission from the District Manager, it shall be discharged through a pipe or hose in a manner such that none of the effluent shall be left adhering to the sides or shelf of the manhole, and if any such effluent is inadvertently allowed to adhere to the sides of shelf or the manhole, the manhole shall be thoroughly cleaned with clear water.
